Guidelines

Criteria: Matted artwork must be flat, two dimensional, and no larger than 24" by 36". Medium may include pen and ink, oils, watercolor, pastels, pencil, photographs, computer art, or collage. No reproductions will be allowed.

No frames please. PLEASE NOTE: 3 Pieces of artwork per school.

Schedule:

Artwork must be submitted to Senator Reed's Cranston office at 1000 Chapel View Boulevard, Suite 290, no later than 4:30 pm on Thursday, May 8, 2008.

Artwork will be judged on Monday, May 12, 2008 at 3:00pm.

The exhibit will be on display in the Warwick Mall foyer from Friday, May 16, 2008 through Friday afternoon, May 23, 2008.

A reception will follow at the Warwick Mall Food Court after a presentation in the foyer in front of the Old Navy store at 6:00 pm on Sunday, May 18th.
