Administrative New:

After-School Day Care: Day Care *will be open on Tuesday, November 10th* (the scheduled date for the H1N1 vaccine clinic). Our facility and staff is only approved to care for 50 maximum number of children on any given day. If your child will be receiving the flu vaccine, it will not be possible (due to fire code restrictions) for you to leave your child at After School Day Care prior to receiving the vaccine **UNLESS your child is a regular participant of the after school program. To those parents who regularly leave their child or children in our care, please note that we cannot accompany your child when it is time for them to receive the vaccine – ONLY A PARENT/GUARDIAN MAY DO SO.** We hope this does not inconvenience anyone, but for the safety of all the children in our care, we must be firm regarding policy.

School Nurse: The H1N1 Vaccine Clinic will be held on Tuesday, November 10th from 4:00-8:00pm. ***Only students of FR. JOHN V. DOYLE SCHOOL who are in grades K-8 will be vaccinated at the clinic.*** Consent forms should be returned to the school before Tuesday. Students who come to the clinic *without* a consent form will have to wait until the end of the clinic to be vaccinated. Information and clinic layout went home with all students today, and also went out on the *listserv*. You may also access this and more information by going to the school website and clicking on the *Nurses Office* tab. **Please** review this material before Tuesday to ensure that we have an efficient vaccine clinic. ***Thank you!***

Please call the school and leave a message when your child will be absent. Please include symptoms, such as cough, sore throat, etc., as well as your child's temperature if he/she has a fever. At this time, ***a temperature is considered a fever if the reading is 100.0 or greater.*** Children with a fever should remain home until they are fever free for 24 hours **without** the use of fever reducing medications such as Motrin or Tylenol.
