

**MIDDLETOWN HIGH SCHOOL**  
**ATHLETIC BOOSTERS MEETING**  
**OCTOBER 15, 2009**

The meeting began at 6PM and adjourned 8PM

**Treasurer's Report** -- The balance in the checking is approximately \$12,000

**Secretaries Report** - Minutes of last month's meeting were handed out and discussed.

**Athletic Director** - Eric presented his agenda (attached). He reviewed the concession stand. He coordinated with Colleen Larson and Andrea Borges to have National Honor Society students to volunteer at the concession stand at Gaudet during football games. The students were very helpful. This worked out great for the boosters as well as the students. The students were able to obtain community service hours. Eric also reviewed the schedule for the concession stand. There were 28 home games for MHS and Gaudet that the concession stand was opened. Eric reviewed the list of team parents and their duties. The team parents coordinated parents to work for the concession stand, distributed the flyer for the social to all parents, sold social tickets and coordinated the basket for the auction at the social. Eric discussed the banners needed. They would cost approximately \$300 for each banner. The varsity banners were approved. The JV banners will be discussed at the next meeting. He also discussed the need for Hockey uniforms. Steve Saunders will submit a request before the first game. They support the boosters with the golf tournament etc. The board decided to pay the bill up to \$2000.

**Fall Social**

Tickets will be \$10 per person. There will be a silent auction, 50/50 raffle and regular raffle. Andrea applied for the raffle permit. Kevin Buck will need a head count as soon as possible for the food. The next social will be held in January.

**Golf Tournament**

Scott will contact the golf course to confirm the date – April 25? Per Renee Breitzke, it is too late to have a student coordinate the golf tournament for a capstone project. This would need to be discussed for the next golf tournament and someone should contact Mrs. Yentch.

**Sports Banquet**

Coaches liked individual dinners. The end of the season banquet would be too long. Give letters to students at the Senior Banquet. Coaches will need to discuss the banquet.

**Funding Tournaments**

The fee of \$100 was suggested at the previous meeting for each team and the students should pick up the remaining fee. Andrea proposed 38 teams (\$100 per team) = \$3800 divide it by 3 season = (approximately) \$1300 per season. This was approved. Harry suggested these requests need to go through Eric.

**Fundraising**

Money must go through boosters and boosters pays the bill or sends check as needed.

**Uniform Inventory**

Scott discussed with Eric the possibility of the uniform inventory. Eric is not required to submit inventory of all equipment. This is already done between Eric and the coaches.

**Football Request**

Last meeting Andy Leys requested \$250 for t-shirts for the football team. He buys t-shirts/shorts for the kids. He fundraised last year and gave \$400 to the boosters. He would like to \$250 to offset the cost for the kids. This was discussed again and the board approved.

**Cheerleading Invoice**

The boosters need the invoice. It was paid with cash/check. The athletic department needs to reimburse the boosters.
