In recognition of our long standing support and cooperation for Salve Regina's educational programs, Sister Therese, President of the University, has offered the Middletown Public Schools a scholarship for one course during the 2007-2008 school year. This is a generous offer from the University. Salve Regina, recognizing the need for professional development that supports the curriculum, has asked the school department to set the criteria for selecting the scholarship recipient. The scholarship course may be at either the graduate or undergraduate level.

The eligibility criteria for determining the recipient for the 2007-2008 scholarship will be:

1. The applicant must be a certified teacher in the Middletown Public Schools.
2. The applicant must submit a letter to the Superintendent of Schools by the close of business on October 5, 2007, addressing the following:
 - a. Name and description of the course.
 - b. How the course addresses improved teaching and learning.
 - c. How the course will support the School Improvement Plan.
 - d. How learning will be shared with others.

The recipient will be notified by October 26, 2007.
