Raymond C. Northup Memorial Scholarship

The Raymond C. Northup Memorial Scholarship is provided by the Rhode Island FFA Foundation, Inc. on a yearly basis. The scholarship honors the memory of the State FFA Advisor responsible for the Agriculture Education and FFA programs in Rhode Island and his promotion and dedication to the programs.

Applicants must show completion of a minimum of 15 credits, with a "C" average or better, in an Agriculture/Education related field of study at the post-secondary level. The scholarship will be paid, in a check made out to the college or university and the student, upon presentation of a school bill for the coming semester.

At the discretion of the review committee, candidates may be asked to appear for an interview.

The guidelines for awarding of the scholarship include, but are not limited to, the following:

Active membership in FFA

Enrolled in a College of Agriculture

Pursuing studies in Agriculture Education

Applicants must provide an official transcript or copy of grades with the application.
