*Are you interested in construction, writing, performing,
and creative problem solving?*

Students from grades K to 5 are invited to join *Destination Imagination* (DI). This national school-friendly program builds creativity, teamwork and problem solving skills through hands-on activities that solve unique challenges. Teams consisting of 5-7 members select one of five challenges, and meet weekly to learn the skills they need to solve their challenge.

DI challenges are fun to solve, and academically-based. This year's challenges and their educational focus include:

- * *RISING STARS* - for students in grades K to 2
- A "*DIrect Deposit*" - Engineering, mathematics, technical design, theater arts
- B "*DI-BOT*" - Robotics, construction, storytelling
- C "*You're Gonna Flip*" - Theater arts, teamwork, storytelling, construction,
- D "*DO or DI*" - Improvisation, acting, story development, research
- E "*Breaking DI News*" - Building, materials science, research, mathematics, theater arts.

Teams will present their solutions in March 2010 at the Rhode Island State Tournament at Cumberland High School. The CSA has approved funds to register 5 teams.
