PTG MEETING MINUTES  
September 19, 2006

Principal Dom Giusti, Co-Presidents Kathy Lewis and Jane Leeds, Vice President Kim Trupiano, Treasurer Sharon Kurose, Volunteer Coordinator Nancy Lamoriello, Secretary Cheri Moss, parent/teacher liaison Renee Hadfield and approximately 45 PTG members were in attendance.

**President's Comments**

Welcome. Introduction of PTG Executive Board. Opening remarks and Recap of school opening and the Back To School Picnic.

**Principal Giusti's Comments**

- 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Field Trip at Project Cope was a success.
- Due to stringent fire codes, we will not be able to have a parent assembly in the building on Open House Night because of the logistics of having too many people in the building at the same time.
- Currently, Eldredge has no fire code issues.
- Open House in 9/27/06 at 7 p.m.

- 10/25/06 the NECAP results will be presented. We will be able to see how the school has fared in relation to the entire state.
- Upcoming dates for Principals Coffee Hour are: October 25<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 a.m. for an overview of last years NECAP results and November 15<sup>th</sup> at 7 p.m. for a joint meeting with Joan Souza of Hanaford. We will discuss Six Traits Training. Renee Hadfield and Pam Testoni (Hanaford) will be training teachers.
- District is still working on the phone system and should have voice mails up and running as soon as possible.
- Everyone should be assured that security around Eldredge has been increased. Pet walking around Eldredge will not be permitted and permanent signs will be posted to that effect.
- EdNets - is a company hired to put together a district web site that will be consistent throughout the EG School District. There is some advertising around the borders of the different web pages on the site. The district will get money if registered parents with an ID make a purchase. The school will get a percentage of that purchase back into an endowment fund. EdNets will present to us at a future meeting.
- NECAP Testing to begin on Wednesday, October 3<sup>rd</sup>. There will be a Report Night in the Spring to review the 2006 NECAP Testing results.
- If you plan to volunteer at Eldredge or any other EG school, you are required to get a background check. Forms will be available at Open House and in the Eldredge Office. The background check is good for 2 years. Drop off completed form in the office or at the EG Police Station.
- Please always stop in the office to get a visitors badge if you are at Eldredge.

#### **Treasurer's Report**

- Proposed Budget for 2006 - 2007 presented by Sharon Kurose.
- The PTG would like to raise \$11,850 this year through the 20 Week Club, Box Tops, Book Fair, Membership, Pasta Night and Sweatshirt Sales. Membership looks good as we have already raised \$4200 (\$200 more than budgeted).
- 6<sup>th</sup> grade t-shirts have been eliminated.
- Many programs have been allocated at least \$200 for startup/seed money.
- Funding for COA has increased from \$800 to \$1200 because they requested it.
- Principals Fund has \$900 in it and will be used at the discretion of the principal.
- \$1000/grade allocated for Field Trips.
- \$1557.91 is a carry over from last year's Library Fund to finish work on the Library.
- Surplus Funds are not always funded but will be decided on a yearly basis. School Bucks refers to \$1 coupons given out by teachers for good behavior, etc.
- Curriculum Enrichment is \$1000 per grade. This year, we are planning science and math curriculum enrichment for each grade. The \$1000 per grade will go toward this enrichment. If there is money left over or a surplus in PTG fundraising, then additional funds may be designated for "other enrichment", i.e., Rooster Games.
- For Teacher Grants, teachers can apply to the PTG for this money w/ a \$250 cap per teacher, i.e., playground equipment purchased last year.
- A question was asked regarding why no Mother/Son Night. Explanation was that no one really ran it and the date conflicted with many events scheduled for the spring. To avoid any conflicts this year, it will be tentatively scheduled for March.
- Motion made by Sara Messier Bomberger to approve the budget. Motion seconded and all in favor by a show of hands. Eldredge PTG 2006-2007 Budget was approved.
- Sharon Kurose requested that all PTG event and program chairs please fill out PTG Reimbursement forms and submit them to Sharon for reimbursement.
- Also new this year is a fundraising form. Please fill this out as it needs to be on file with the district. Forms will be in the PTG box in the office.

- Book Fair - Closet near Book Fair location can be used as a temporary storage facility during Book Fair, per Principal Giusti. Books will be arriving October 10<sup>th</sup>. 10/13 and 10/16 will be Book Fair Preview days for any teachers that want to come by and preview. Need volunteers. Testing is also that week, so a schedule will be worked out.
- School Store is open on Wednesdays during lunch and needs volunteers.
- Directory should be in print by the end of the week.
- Need a volunteer to help organize Mr. Roberrsons Room.
- Principal Giusti announced that the Homework Club, which had previously lost funding, will begin by the end of October due entirely to contributions of volunteers. He has spoken w/ the E.G.
